SCHEDULE "H" OF BY-LAW 2016-25

KENNEL

Applicable to:	Every person who operates a business where dogs are bred and/or raised or are boarded.
Definitions:	<p><b>KENNEL</b> shall mean any building, structure, dog run or other facility or part thereof where:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Dogs are kept for breeding or boarding purposes; or</li><li>2. Dogs are kept solely for the purpose or routinely entering into dog sled rides and/or races.</li></ol>
Exemptions:	The requirement to obtain a kennel license does not apply to a veterinary clinic, animal hospital or pet store.
General Conditions:	<p>Every person who owns or operates a Kennel within the Municipality shall ensure compliance with the following regulations:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Shall permit an Officer, Police Officer and/or the Humane Society to enter and inspect the kennel at all reasonable times, upon production of proper identification.</li><li>2. Where an Officer, Police Officer or the Humane Society finds that the owner or operator does not comply with any of the regulations of this by-law, the dogs may be seized and impounded.</li><li>3. The building in which the Kennel is situated shall conform to the Ontario Building Code.</li><li>4. Shall ensure that the kennel is operated in the permitted zone as indicated in the Municipality's Zoning By-law.</li><li>5. The Kennel shall be maintained in a clean and sanitary condition with all excrement, dead animals and other waste being removed on a daily basis.</li><li>6. Shall ensure every dog is supplied with adequate amounts of water and food.</li><li>7. Shall ensure the Kennel is provided with adequate</li></ol>

	natural or artificial light, proper ventilation and sufficient heat to maintain healthy conditions for the dogs.
